



Wedding Photos in Parks

Falkirk Community Trust operate Callendar Park, Helix Park, Kinneil Estate and Muiravonside Country Park. If you wish to have photographs taken by a professional firm please make them aware they need to book well in advance and that there is a small charge of £25 for special access to Callendar Park, Kinneil Estate and Muiravonside Country Park. Helix Park operates a 'price on application' policy. As a charity this money is used to support the services we provide. The booking forms can be found at the end of this document and there are several important conditions of use which you must abide by. All visitors are welcome to take snapshots in all parks at any time but these should not be sold or used for commercial gain and no special access arrangements will be made to facilitate this type of casual photography.

Callendar Park

1. You can drive one wedding car around to the back of the house, all other cars must be parked in the general public car park not in front of the house or in the disabled spaces, unless displaying appropriate blue badges.
2. To protect the safety of other park users please drive at no more than 10miles an hour and ensure hazard lights are on while the vehicle is in motion.
3. All damage must be paid for. Please ensure vehicles stay on the hard surface path.
4. The park is a no drinking zone. Please do not bring alcohol into the park.
5. Use of the house, including the outside steps, as a photographic location is reserved exclusively for those booking a room in the house for their wedding reception.

Helix Park

Kinneil Estate

1. You can drive a maximum of one wedding car up the red blaes path to the front of the house for the purpose of taking wedding photos.
2. To protect the safety of other park users please drive at no more than 10miles an hour and ensure hazard lights are on while the vehicle is in motion.
3. All damage must be paid for. Please ensure vehicles stay on the hard surface path.
4. The park is a no drinking zone. Please do not bring alcohol into the park.
5. There is no access to the house.

Muiravonside Country Park

1. Wedding photos can be taken in the park, recommended spots include the teasel sculpture at the top of the meadow and the veteran oak tree on the route up to the café used in a key Outlander TV series scene.
2. The park is a no drinking zone. Please do not bring alcohol into the park.
3. Please do not drive any cars outside of the existing routes permitted to public vehicles

Other popular parks for wedding photographs include Dollar Park. This site, and the majority of other parks within Falkirk are run by Falkirk Council. Some details are given overleaf but if you have specific questions please contact them direct on 01324 506074. We cannot take bookings.

Dollar Park

You are welcome to get your wedding photos taken in Dollar Park, provided no vehicles go on the grass and no damage is caused.

If you wish to get photos taken in the Dollar Park Walled Garden, you need to contact the Cyrenians to book. The charge is £50 + VAT = £60. Please contact Sue Bytheway:
