CINEMA WITH A WARM WELCOME

Did you read recently about Netflix's decision to abandon its "star rating" system for films and T.V. shows on its online streaming service? The "out-of-five" star system, which showed you the overall popularity amongst all Netflix viewers, has been replaced by a simple thumbs up/thumbs down icon. Netflix analyses what you watch and predicts what you would like to see; they say that this change will make the service better at suggesting titles you'll like. I wonder if this move is likely to narrow our viewing habits, deterring us from trying something new? At the Hippodrome I seek out films that I hope you would give the thumbs up even if they are a departure from your regular diet of choices. 'Lady Macbeth' is an independent British feature without big name stars and unlikely to benefit from road-side hoardings. It is a costume drama but with none of the cosy trappings of the genre – riveting, original, likened to 'Wuthering Heights', 'Madame Bovary' and 'Lady Chatterley'. Give it a go.

If 'Lady Macbeth' is well within your viewing comfort zone maybe you could mix things up a bit with 'Guardians of the Galaxy 2', featuring a top soundtrack provided by Peter Quill's (a.k.a. Star-Lord) 'Awesome Mix Tape Volume 2'! Incidentally 'Lady Macbeth' and 'GOTG 2' scored a high 85% and 86% on the popular film critique review site Rotten Tomatoes, so perhaps you will be surprised by the kind of film that scores highly with you!

Scoring higher than either of these is 'The Red Turtle' – a magnificent, circle-of-life animated fable for adults, presented by the ever popular Studio Ghibli. It's dialogue-free, beautiful and moving, and a world away from anything else in the programme this month. You can also take your pick from gorgeous adaptations 'The Secret Scripture' and Daphne DuMaurier's 'My Cousin Rachel', our live presentation of the new National Theatre interpretation of 'Salome', as well as a broad range of family films before we get in to full summer holiday mode next month.

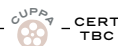

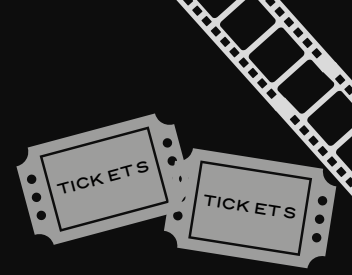
